## Dear Paisley Parent,

At the end of May 2018, it came to the attention of the administration that Paisley School had experienced a security breach of ALMA, our school-information-system. Several staff passwords had been compromised and used by students to login and change grades over the course of several months. While the tampered grades have been corrected, a criminal investigation is underway with cooperation from the Lake County District Attorney and the Oregon State Police.

Paisley School District staff have reviewed our security procedures and have made changes to assure a similar breach will not happen in the future. We have also contracted a private cyber security firm in order to conduct an audit of our digital resources. We will put additional measures into place to enhance the security of our digital information.

As you know, the world of technology is constantly changing. As such, methods to defeat security threats must constantly change, as well. Know that our primary concern is to ensure the safety and well-being of your students, including all aspects of their life at school. We will remain vigilant in this goal.
